Board Meeting Minutes

Chris Ahne called the meeting to order and recapped many of the awards our Chapter received at CRC. Chris also explained the Presidential Award of Excellence (PAOE) points system for rating chapters.

Bill Harrison, Society Past President, stopped in to offer a few observations and insights about ASH-RAE. Bill praised the Arkansas Chapter and thanked those in attendance for contributing to an important cause. Bill reasoned that Region VIII invests about \$5 million per year in time and money of which it wouldn't be a stretch to claim that the Arkansas Chapter is responsible for at least 1/10 or about \$500,000. He then explained how ASHRAE delivers value for that sizable investment. His list of ASHRAE benefits included employers getting the first look at the best and brightest engineering students, members developing their leadership skills as they move through the chapter chairs, and of course the valuable technical content presented at tech sessions, programs, seminars and broadcasts. Bill summarized the value of ASHRAE by asserting 'you get what you put in' and attributed much of his success in business to his involvement in ASHRAE on all levels. In conclusion, Bill highlighted the activities of ASHRAE on a society level explaining that the main focus right now is to take energy out of buildings and to move toward net zero and that the focus going forward will also be to develop cheap and reliable sources of renewable energy.

Chris reminded everyone that the upcoming CRC will be in Monterrey, Mexico and strongly encouraged everyone to attend. Steve Titus echoed the importance of attending CRC citing the leadership training, the opportunity to direct our society by making motions at the business meeting, and networking with other professionals as a few reasons to go.

Chris solicited the meeting attendees to develop the following list of the Arkansas Chapter's strengths and challenges.

Strengths: organization/MBO; meeting attendance; technical content of programs; generosity (time and money); newsletter; volunteerism; social functions; investment in student activities (scholarships and student membership dues); the NW Section

Challenges: membership delinquencies, renewal and growth; involvement of principals at engineering firms; broadcasting and advertising of chapter events/relevant communication; individual donations; other social activities besides the golf tournament

Chris demonstrated the Chapter Buddy software including the software's features for exporting e-mail lists, generating letters (such as one to remind delinquent members to renew their membership), generating rosters, etc. The cost of the software is \$75. Kim Koch made a motion to purchase the software and Steve Titus seconded. The motion was approved by acclamation.

Chris reviewed last year's PAOE point totals by committee and encouraged committee chairs to coordinate their plans for the year with their respective Regional Vice-chairs (RVCs). Committee chairs broke into groups to set goals, budget needs and schedules.

Upon reconvening, Chris summarized the action items to be completed before the next planning meeting. Those included finding a research promotion chair for Northwest Arkansas (Chris Ahne), setting the topics for this year's programs (Steve Keen), e-mailing chapter leadership contacts (Chris Ahne), e-mail current budget (Marc White) and contacting respective RVCs (committee chairs).

Chris announced that the next planning meeting will be August 11 and the first Central Arkansas Chapter Meeting will be September 2.
