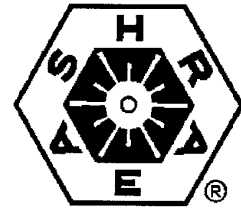

2009 Arkansas ASHRAE Spring Golf Tournament

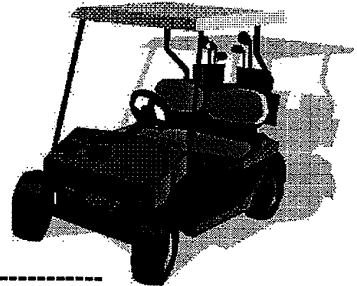

Special contests to be announced.



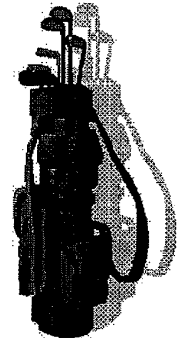
